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## **Explanation of Course Formats:**

### **Weekend Course:**

Students begin on their reading assignments a few weeks before meeting for a class weekend at Saint Meinrad, where they are in class all day Saturday and Sunday (with a break for Mass on Sunday). They have two more such weekends, spaced roughly a month apart, between which they work on assignments. Final assignments are generally due about a week or two after the final class weekend. The weekend course counts as residential credit, and entails approximately 39 clock hours of instruction. Temporary on-campus housing is available for weekend students. Because of coinciding course dates and instruction times, it is not possible to take more than one weekend course per term.

### **Intensive Residential/Hybrid:**

The intensive residential course entails a short period of campus residency. In most cases, this will be augmented with longer-term, distance-based work, which may begin before the residency. This is considered residential credit.

### **Workshop:**

Saint Meinrad offers in-person workshops in continuing formation, painting religious icons, and liturgical music/chant. Workshops are generally one or two credits and can be taken by degree-seeking or non-degree-seeking students. Continuing formation workshops are often held on a Thursday evening through Friday evening prior to one of the weekend courses. Chant workshops tend to be held on a Monday through a Friday. Often workshops are open to non-students in the form of a non-credit option.

### **Online Course:**

Offered over the spring, fall, or summer, online courses are completely distance-based courses. Online classes may involve different methods making use of the School's online course management system. They generally entail weekly reading, writing, and discussion-board assignments; most courses include video lectures. Most courses are asynchronous, meaning that students may log on at different times to complete each week's work. Some may occasionally be synchronous, meaning that students and teacher log on and connect at the same time.

Courses need to have at least 6 students enrolled in order to run.
